Men's Rights Activists are the Neelkanths of the society. Perform Pisachini Mukti Pooja & Pindaan in Varanasi to Save Men!

- Neelkanths to Save MENkind theme is declared as the theme of the National Conference on Men's Issues.
- Pisachini Mukti Pooja organized to save men, government and the judiciary from the fake cases filed by *pishachinis* i.e. the wicked women.
- Pind Daan of Matrimony was done by people who survived the fake cases filed by their wives and in-laws.
- Talent Hunt Competition was organized to groom the future Men's Rights Activists.
- Memento and prize distribution for the winners & participants.
- Next National Meet to be held on a larger scale.

'Neelkanths to Save MENkind', was the declared theme of the 10th National Conference on Men's Rights, being held in the city of Varanasi. Anupam Dubey the Organising Secretary elaborated upon the theme by drawing a parallel between Lord Shiva and the Men's Rights Activists (MRA). He explained that Lord Shiva is believed to have consumed poison to save the world and was thus named as The Neelkanth. Similarly, the MRAs are The Neelkanths who are consuming the poison of the society to make this planet a better place for the men.

The second day of the conference started with the MRAs organising a '*Pishachini Mukti Pooja*'. This pooja was a prayer to save the men from wicked women who file fake cases on men. It was also prayed that the government and judiciary comes out of the influence of these *pishachinis* - the wicked women. In Indian mythology a *Pishach* is an evil soul of a person who is yet to attain salvation. Just like Shiva, the MRAs are doing a great service to the society and working to make this world a better place for the males. It could your sons, fathers and any male relative too. Varanasi has a *Pisach Mochan* Temple but there was no Pisachini Mochan temple. Is it not a gender biased situation?
